<u>MinnesotaHelp.info</u><sup>®</sup> is Minnesota's online database of more than 40,000 health care, social services and community resources. Use it to find services for clients who qualify for waiver services. This helpful website includes resources for older adults, people with disabilities, caregivers, parents and families and people with low income.

A product of the Minnesota Board on Aging and the Area Agencies on Aging, <u>MinnesotaHelp.info<sup>®</sup></u> contains the statewide resource referral information used by the Senior LinkAge Line<sup>®</sup>, the Disability Linkage Line<sup>®</sup> and the Veterans Linkage Line<sup>™</sup>. It is also used by county and tribal staff and health plans to find agencies that are enrolled Minnesota Health Care Programs waiver service providers.

#### **Searching for Resources**

A. Begin your search by going to MinnesotaHelp.info®.



B. Select the Waiver & Alternative Care Program Services link.



**c.** You can search for services by entering a **Key Word** into the **Search Box**, by **Topic** on the left side of the page, or search using a specific **NPI number**, if you know it.



D. Search results will default to within five miles of your location. You can change it to a greater or lesser distance. You can filter your results by typing in the Filter Search Box, or by selecting from the Left Nav. Menu, which features drop-down menu choices.
