



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Dear Care Coordination Partners,

Now that MnCHOICES phase 1 has launched, Bridgeview has been updated to include MnCHOICES ASSESSMENT and HRA-MCO as options under HRA Form Used:



HRA Form Drop Down Options	Select based on the type of HRA that was completed.
LTCC	Long-Term Care Consultation Form DHS 3428 (or DHS 3428A)
6.15 NH ASSESSMENT	6.15 NH-ICF Member Annual Assessment-Care Plan Review has been completed. (For members residing in the nursing facility or Intermediate Care Facility (ICF).
6.28 TRANS HRA	6.28 Transitional HRA is completed in combination with review of newly enrolled members MnCHOICES assessment; LTCC; or 3428H within the past 365 days.

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MnCHOICES ASSESSMENT	Select when a Blue Plus Care Coordinator completes a full MnCHOICES assessment in the Revised MnCHOICES application.
FEE FOR SERVICE/REVIEWED HRA	For Transitional HRAs select this to document the date of the previous MnCHOICES; LTCC; or 3428H assessment that was completed prior to enrollment. Follow the process outlined below in section, <i>LTCC/MnCHOICES completed prior to enrollment</i> .
NO FORM	For Refusals and Unable to Reach.
6.28.01 NH TRANS HRA	Transitional HRA nursing home/ICF members who have a product change. CC completes Section VI of the 6.15 NH-ICF Member Annual Assessment-Care Plan Review that was completed within the past 365 days.
3428H	Minnesota Health Risk Assessment Form DHS 3428H completed for CW members. For use with CW members not on EW nor receiving PCA Services, and for those members on another waiver. Cannot be used to determine eligibility for EW or PCA.
HRA-MCO	Select when a Blue Plus Care Coordinator completes a HRA-MCO in the Revised MnCHOICES application. To be completed following above 3428H parameters.

Bridgeview Care Coordinator User Guide will be updated with the above information in the next update.

With the MnCHOICES launch, Blue Plus’s guidance for offering assessment options to Community members has changed in the following ways.

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Situation	Required assessment/offering
Community Well member accessing PCA Services	Full MnCHOICES Assessment/LTCC
Elderly Waiver	Full MnCHOICES Assessment/LTCC
Community Well member not accessing PCA or Elderly Waiver	*Offer in-person MCO-HRA/3428H. If refused, offer telephonic MCO-HRA/3428H. Document both offerings in case notes.

Due to the Revised MnCHOICES roll out, see below regarding MMIS and Bridgeview entry requirements.

Scenario	Discard or Complete?	MMIS Entry Required?	Bridgeview Entry Required?	MnCHOICES special instructions, if any
MnCHOICES assessment	Complete	Yes	Yes	
MCO-HRA	Complete	No	Yes	
Transitional HRA	Complete	No	Yes	Complete the required fields in the "Member Information" and "Assessment Information" sections of the Transitional HRA and mark as complete. (Note: A transitional HRA can be marked "Complete" without fulfilling completion requirements)
Refusals	Discard	No	Yes	Complete the required fields in the "Member Information" and "Assessment Information" sections and mark HRA as discarded.

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Unable to Reach	Discard	No	Yes	Complete the required fields in the “Member Information” and “Assessment Information” sections and mark HRA as discarded.
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See below for an illustration of how to close the HRA in the revised MnCHOICES by changing the status to “Discard” for Refusal and Unable to Reach.

Directions: Cannot complete an HRA for some assessment results

If “Person declines health risk assessment” or “Person not located for health risk assessment” is selected, the user should close the HRA by changing the status to “Discard”.

This will allow the HRA to be closed without fulfilling the remaining completion requirements.

Managed care system staff will need to consider this when using the MnCHOICES data.
